Ragazzi Continuo, the men's a cappella choir composed of alumni of the acclaimed Ragazzi Boys Chorus, invites you to join it at its first inperson concert since 2019, NORTHERN LIGHTS. This remarkable vocal ensemble will present an eclectic and deeply moving program which evokes the depth and beauty of the night sky. Featuring a number

Continuo will also perform songs from around the world which highlight the inspiration that the sky and stars bring to all, including the late Canadian composer Diane Loomer's "Ave Maris Stella", Eric Whitacre's celestial "Lux Aurumque", and Hungarian composer Zoltán Kodaly's "Esti Dal" or, "Evening Song".
